Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Timber Lake, 700 Main St., PO Box 431, Timber Lake, South Dakota, 57656, 605-865-3790, until 5:00 PM local time on Monday the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 2024 for the above referenced project. Bids shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with the Bidding Documents. The City of Timber Lake reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all Bids as set forth in the Bidding Documents.

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at or shortly after 6:00 PM on Monday the 28<sup>th</sup> of October at the Timber Lake City Hall, 700 Main Street, Timber Lake, South Dakota, 57656. Bids will be reviewed by the City of Timber Lake at a subsequent meeting of the board.

The Project includes the following Work:

- **Base Bid** - Remove asphalt surfacing, concrete curb & gutter, gravel surfacing, remove and replace culverts, removal/abandon existing 4-inch water main, remove and salvage fire hydrants. Traffic control, seeding, fertilizing, fiber mulching, erosion control wattles, and erosion control blanket are also included.

Install 7,329 feet of 6-inch water main, 1,019 feet of 8-inch water main, 44 six-inch gate valves, 12 fire hydrants, 95 one-inch saddles with corporation stops, 3,545 feet of one-inch service line, and tracer wire throughout the new system.

Surfacing includes 790 TN of aggregate base course, 360 TN of asphalt concrete pavement, 3,360 TN of gravel surfacing, 288 SF of concrete sidewalk, 82 SY of concrete valley gutter, and 55 LF of curb and gutter.

- **Alternate Bid A**- Install 5,239 feet of 6-inch water main, 30 gate valves, 8 fire hydrants, 43 one-inch saddles with corporation stops, 1,513 feet of one-inch service line, and tracer wire throughout the new system.

Surfacing includes 1,080 TN of aggregate base course, 605 TN of asphalt concrete pavement, 655 TN of gravel surfacing, 59 SF of concrete sidewalk, and 24 SY of concrete driveway.

- **Alternate Bid B**- Install 3,350 feet of 6-inch water main, 13 gate valves, 3 fire hydrants, 12 one-inch saddles with corporation stops, 380 feet of one-inch service line, and tracer wire throughout the new system.

Surfacing includes 1,250 TN of gravel surfacing, 35 SF of concrete sidewalk, and 103 SF of PCC Fillet Section, and 79 LF of concrete curb and gutter.



- Additional items as set forth in the Contract Documents.

The Work to be performed under this contract shall be substantially completed by September 30, 2026.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security as described in the Bidding Documents. The Successful Bidder will be required to provide Payment and Performance Bonds as described in the Bidding Documents.

Bidders shall comply with the Equal Opportunity Clause published at 41 CFR Part 60 and Executive Orders 11246, 11518, and 11625, as amended. This requires Bidders will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. Requirements are explained further in the specifications.

Bidders on this work shall be required to comply with Title 40 CFR 33 and Executive Order 12138. The requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this regulation which concerns utilization of Disadvantaged/Minority Business Enterprises (DBE/MBE) and Women’s Business Enterprises (WBE) are explained in the specifications. The DBE/MBE and WBE goals for participation in this contract in terms of percentage of contract value are as follows:

The low responsive bidder will be required to certify to compliance with the **American Iron and Steel** provision of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014. This certification form may be found on page AIS-21 and 22 of the State Revolving Fund (SRF) General Conditions and must be included in the bid proposal.

Please be advised that waivers or exemptions from the **American Iron and Steel** provision that cite International Trade Agreements **DO NOT** comply with the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 as it applies to the SRF programs. Claims from suppliers that the **American Iron and Steel** provision does not apply to certain products based on the International Trade Agreement exemptions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 will not be accepted.

BABA is not a requirement of this project. However, this project may be partially funded using American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. As a condition of the ARPA funding guidelines, the
