Chapter 1.01 – Penalties and Policies

CHAPTER 1.01 - PENALTIES AND POLICIES

- 1.0101 Penalty in General. Except in cases where a different or additional penalty is imposed by this ordinance or by some existing provisions of South Dakota State law, every violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable as a Class 2 Misdemeanor under South Dakota statures, and shall be subject to the maximum fines and imprisonment provided for Class 2 misdemeanor violations.
- 1.0102 Conflicting Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, or relating to the subject matter of this ordinance and not re-enacted as part of this ordinance, are hereby repealed; special ordinances, appropriation ordinances, levying ordinances for the issuance of bonds, or other special ordinances of like character, nor shall this ordinance repeal or modify the provisions of any ordinance heretofore adopted by the City unless provisions of this ordinance in effect, either modify, repeal or amend such ordinances.
- 1.0103 <u>Severability</u>. If any section of this Municipal Code is declared unconstitutional or the application thereof to any person or circumstances held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the constitutionality of the remained of the Municipal Code and applicability thereof to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
- 1.0104 <u>Publication and Effect</u>. The ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication of the notice of such adoption as provided by SDCL 9-19-17.
- 1.0105 Boundaries. The corporate limits of the City are declared to be such as have been legally established and amended by law and ordinances of the City as shown on the official map on file in the office of the Finance Officer. Such map shall be incorporated in this ordinance by reference and adopted as the official map showing the boundaries and limits of the City.
